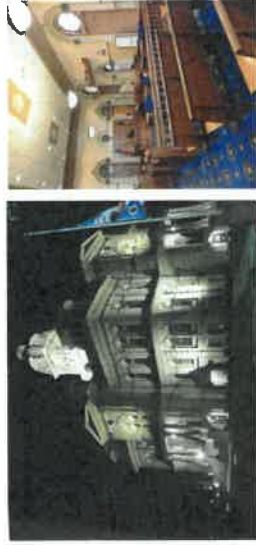

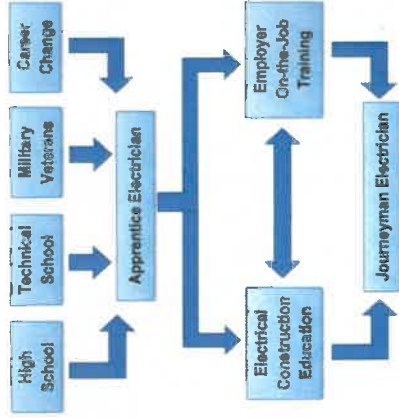

- Apprenticeship is a combination of 8,000 hours of on-the-job training and 576 hours of classroom instruction.
- You are gainfully employed while receiving on-the-job training.
- The program takes approximately 4 years to complete.
- Program completion results in journeyman certification from the U.S. Department of Labor Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training and the Ohio State Apprenticeship Council.
- Program completion can also transfer into college credits toward a degree in a related field.

How To Get Started

- **GET A HEAD START IN HIGH SCHOOL with the SCHOOL-TO APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM!** Students who enroll in the Electrical Trades program through their local Career Center their Junior year in high school may be eligible to start working their Senior year through the School-to-Apprenticeship Program.
- **STANDARD APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM.** High school graduates can enter into the apprenticeship program.
- **MILITARY VETERANS.** Military veterans who have gained knowledge and experience during their military career can enter into the apprenticeship program sometimes at a higher level.
- **CAREER CHANGE.** Too many people are stuck in dead-end jobs headed nowhere. An apprenticeship program can open up a world of opportunities leading to a good paying career in the electrical field.
